- Established in Grundy, Virginia, in 1921
- Focuses on children who are coming out of difficult home environments — poverty, violence, loss of parent figures
- Serves the needs of children as young as 18 months up to older teens, and provides them a stable home/family environment
- Cares for 250-300 children at any given time
- Receives no government funding; operations rely solely on charitable donations
- 70 percent of children come from the U.S., including urban areas such as D.C. and Baltimore
- 30 percent originate outside the U.S.
- Children and staff all reside on grounds and share communal meals
- 95 percent of MMS graduates go on to attend college, and nearly
- 100 percent of these graduates begin their career debt-free with the help of the United Company Foundation
- Supporters come from all financial strata, from those who can give a few dollars on up to those who have made supporting the school a central financial commitment
- Has served approximately 20,000 children over the course of its history
